

VD (1) Lovatt's Ir Sh Ch Beechllawn I'm Free With Shirostar CW19 7 year old with pleasing masculine well-proportioned head with kind tight eye , well set ears, straight forelegs, well placed shoulders, strong top line, muscular loin leading to strong thighs, moved OK but carrying a tail rather high

PD (3) 1 Toynebee Smith's Bareve Bronski Beat Really fell for this boy who was so well constructed overall and presented a lovely outline for such a young boy at only 6 months, masculine head but not overdone and in balance with his body, excellent expression from dark tight eye, clean neck leading to well laid shoulder and upper arm, firm top line and strong quarters in proportion to body with well bent stifle, when settled he used his hocks to advantage on the move where he covered the ground with ease. An exciting youngster and I wish him well. BP Geary's Westley Vom Alto Wald At Germanus (Raf Naf) (Imp) Very unlucky to meet 1 as he is another quality puppy with many of the attributes and construction of 1 but was moving just a tad close on front today and it was this minor point that split the two. Very close decision.

PGD (1) 1 Simpson's Greendale Ash This boy had good breadth of skull and well-proportioned head with kind expression and good ear set, straight forelegs, good lay of shoulder with correct upper arm, Strong top line, adequate quarters and moved happily and true front and rear

LD (3, 1) 1 Chrystie's Bareve Best Done Now He was very balanced in outline with such a true GWP head and expression, masculine but not overdone in any way, excellent construction both front and rear with corresponding angles, tight elbows, strong top line and moved so well with such ease, true front and rear with reach in front and drive from strong well angled quarters.

Pressed hard in the challenge where it was a very close decision. RCC 2 Blanco & Osbourne's Lux Vom Maibrook (Imp Ger) Pleasing head, good bone, reasonable shoulder construction, good top line, adequate rear and moved OK though a bit close in front and not as balanced as 1 in outline.

OD (2) 1 Pinkerton & Alimov's Sh Ch /Ch Matze Vom Alte Wald (Imp) Presented an excellent outline with correct body proportions, broad rounded skull, moderate stop, straight bone, correct length of neck into well laid shoulders with return of upper arm, strong top line leading to muscular quarters from which he moved with drive covering the ground with such ease holding his strong top line and good tail carriage whilst being true both front and rear and moved with animation. CC 2 O'Connor's Sh Ch Karlejay Gump They Live In Yu (ai) Very close up with lots to like as he also ticks all of the boxes with true head & expression, well-constructed front and hindquarters with balance through body from correct depth of chest, well sprung ribs to tucked up loin. Just lost out to 1 who was just a tad more positive on rear movement.

VB (1) 1 Chrystie's Bareve Bela Bela This 9year old bitch still presents a very balanced outline, she has a feminine head with pleasing expression but not weak in any way, very well laid shoulder with return of upper arm keeping adequately boned legs under body, depth of chest fitting with body and strong quarters from which she moved well. A credit to her owner. BV

PB (2) Two quality pups who must have an exciting future 1 O'Brien's Caldewriver Storm N' Teacup For Katillien Feminine balanced head with tight eye, straight forelegs with nice bone, compact feet, well-constructed shoulders, chest deep enough for age and well ribbed, strong top line and well bent stifle with strong hocks, she moved well with both reach in front and drive from strong quarters 2 Pinkerton's Bareve Bananarama This bitch was also a joy to go over as she was so well constructed overall with well-balanced head and well-shaped eye giving an intelligent expression with a hint of mischievousness, sloping shoulder with well-constructed upper arm, strong top line and wide thigh with good bend of stifle, with this construction I'm sure she could move so well but was just out for fun today and did not settle on the move long enough to assess. Her time will come I'm sure.

JB (3,1) 1 Geary's Germanus Hotwyr Minjarra This bitch was the better mover and held better balance on the move, true head & expression, well set ears, strong neck of good length, well laid shoulders with correct upper arm, deep chest, well ribbed, strong top line and well-muscled rear from which she moved with drive covering the ground easily and true front and rear. 2 Newton's Germanus Makin A Ripple With Layasway This girl has similar head and front construction to 1 and held a strong top line but did not have the same strength of hindquarters as 1 and her high tail carriage detracted from her overall balance on the move though she did move true front and rear.

SBB (2) Simpson's Hermione 'Vom Holstef This girl presented the more balanced outline, well boned, pleasing head of good proportions, reasonable angles both front and rear and moved well

using muscular quarters to advantage. 2 Clements' Lower Dee Willow Reasonable head, well set ears, good length of neck and adequate shoulder construction, moved quite well on rear but had a tendency to pin on front.

PGB (5) 1 Jenkins & Warner's Tickencote Teach Me Tonight For Gerstenfeld JW I loved this bitch's movement which was true with good front extension and drive from the rear, typical feminine head with expressive eyes, enough length of neck into well constructed front assembly, deep through chest & well ribbed through well-proportioned body to strong quarters 2 Stamp's Tynsil Just One Smile Close up and unlucky to meet 1 who was so precise on the move, Very well constructed throughout from well-made head through sloping shoulder with correct upper arm keeping nicely boned legs well under body, deep chest well ribbed strong top line leading to well angled quarters from which she moved with drive but just not as precise as 1 on front movement today and that is what split them. 3 Geary's Germanus Hotwyr Minjarra

LB (4, 1) 1 O'Connor's Karlejay Gump Circle Of Life (ai) This lady certainly took my eye as she entered the ring, she was so balanced in profile, her head with intelligent feminine expression, correct depth of chest, strong neck of good length, correct lay of shoulders and length of upper arm, firm back and nicely angled muscular quarters all gave a true picture of the breed She moved very well using quarters to advantage along with good reach in front whilst holding firm top line and pleasing head carriage Pressed hard for top honours RCC 2 Clements' Lower Dee Willow Close up in many respects but was not so true in front movement as 1 today but liked her head which was balanced in line with body, her chest and rib were as required, she was well constructed both in forequarters and hindquarters with strong top line. She used her hocks on the move giving good drive from the rear. 3 Turnbull's Kimmax Two Can Play At Elagram (Ai)

OB (3) McCullough's Kimmax Koz I Kan This bitch oozes quality, true breed type and presents such a balanced and eye catching outline standing on good compact tight feet with well arched toes, her head is so balanced and her expression so kind and intelligent with well shaped eye of correct colour, straight nicely boned forelegs with nothing overdone, correct depth of chest, tight elbows and excellent forehand construction, well ribbed, strong top line, broad hips and well-constructed muscular rear. In fact everything as it should be and this girl is well able to fit her purpose as a "strong versatile hunting dog". Her movement was faultless and a joy to watch as she covered the ground with such ease showing reach on front and strong drive from well laid hocks. CC, BOB and was pleased to see her being shortlisted in a strong Gundog group. Well done indeed. O'Brien's Sh Ch Luchanalilly Cute Coral Of Calderiver Another lovely well constructed and balanced bitch with all the attributes from well-proportioned head through good front assembly to well-made muscular quarters. Moved with drive holding strong top line. 3

GCB (1) Kearn's Rudishaw Waltzing Matilda Good head and eye, clean neck and correct bone, deep chest, reasonable shoulder construction, slightly longer in loin but well-constructed quarters and moved well.
