

I would like to thank Three Counties committee for inviting me to judge at this show. Despite having a low number of dogs, I was pleased with the quality that was presented under me.

JD (1) Jones' Germanus Makin A Point (AI) At 12 months old, this dog has a well balanced head, with correct moderate stop and strong neck that leads to a nice firm and straight topline. A nice harsh wiry coat. Moved with ease around the ring.

PGD (2) 1 Donnelly's Kimmax They Kall Me Mr Tibbs. This black and white dog is well proportioned in outline. The head and skull are balanced and broad, with a moderate stop and muzzle of equal length. A strong and adequately long neck leads to muscular shoulders. Forequarters are straight and elbows sit close to body. Deep chest and well sprung ribs, this dog moves with drive from the rear. Well furnished. RBD. 2 Hewins' Xaver Iv V Bockenhagen NAF This dog has a robust and sufficient length of neck, which flows into sloping muscular shoulders. Presenting ribs that are well sprung and a sturdy back, this dogs hindquarters are well muscled and have well bent stifles. Moved with drive.

OD (2,1) 1 Donnellys' Sh Ch/ Ir Sh Ch Kimmax Knock Yourself Out JW ShCM. This dog oozes style and type. Beautiful in outline, this dog is well proportioned and has a nice wiry textured coat. Head is sufficiently broad and eyes are of oval shape and dark. Shoulders slope and elbows are kept close to the body. Forequarters are straight and stands on close knit feet. With well sprung ribs, this dog has a firm back which slightly slopes to tail. Moved with drive from the rear. Pleased to have awarded him BD & BOB. PGB (3) Very similar in style and type so was hard to make a decision. It was not till after judging that I was told that these two were mother and daughter. 1 Flatt's Kimmax Keep My Actions Klear for Belstock. Despite being the younger of the two, this bitch still possess maturity and is well proportioned. With a pretty head and soft expression, this bitch carries herself well. With good depth and balance, she has a nice clean front, and well sprung rib. Lovely width to the hindquarters and has a nice turn of stifle. Moved with ease around the ring. RBB. 2 Donnelly's Kimmax Who Kares Wins JW. This bitch has a feminine head with a kind expression and deep dark eye colour. Well balanced on the move and when stacked, she has a nice strong neck, correct shoulder placement and elbows tight to chest. With a good depth of chest and straight topline, she has sufficient turn of stifle. Moves with drive from the rear. 3 Stamp's Tynsil Just One Smile.

OB (4,1) 1 McCullough's Sh Ch Kimmax Kindly Stand Black. This bitch caught my eye as soon as she walked into the ring. With a striking and well balanced outline, she maintains this when on the move. Feminine, this bitch has a well proportioned yet strong head with a nice deep eye colour. Straight in front, she has a deep well sprung ribs. Good bend of stifle and powerful hindquarters. Moved well around the ring and nice harsh coat.BB. 2 Donnelly's Sh Ch Beechillawn Oooh Betty. This bitch has an

attractive head, with a lovely expression and kind eye. With nice furnishings throughout she is well balanced and has nice angulation in the hindquarters. With correct amount of bone, she holds her topline well. 3 Lovatt's Ir Sh Ch Beechillawn Amarillo Starlight of Shirostar Cjw19
