- JD (3) 1 Johnston's Germanus Plot Twist. 16 month liver and white boy with an excellent coat, well constructed and with good bone producing substance. Handsome head, with dark oval eyes not too deep set, correct ear shape set high on skull, strong neck going into well laid shoulders and a deep chest, straight forelegs with slightly sloping pasterns, well sprung ribs with a slightly sloping topline and broad hips, oval shaped feet with heavy nails, correct tail set continuing the line of the back. Moved soundly covering plenty of ground Pleased to award him his first CC. Should have a bright future. 2 Geary's Germanus Hit The Jackplot. Litter brother to my CC winner and a lot of the same remarks apply Preferred the topline of first, although he had better head furnishings. Moved on a free stride and co-operated well with his new handler. RCC. 3 Quinn's Kentwone Cloudberry.
- PGD (1) 1 Hutchinson & Sherdan's Hartperry Green Gentleman. Good looking upstanding male with an excellent coat. Slightly rounded skull with a moderate stop and correct head proportions. Adequate length of neck and good lay of shoulder, straight forelegs and slightly sloping pasterns, good hind angulation but a little short in rib. He is a son of an old favourite of mine.
- OD (3) 1 Geary's Germanus Go Dutch. Another nice dog from this kennel with a good tight fitting jacket, equal head proportions with high set ears reaching to corner of lips. Slightly sloping topline, beat another nice dog on his sound movement Sure they will changes many times. 2 Getting's Kiss My Blackside At Beechillawn. Not as mature as first but he will trouble the best of him when he matures. Well balanced young dog with the very best of feet and well rounded toes good hind angulation but not moving out as well as first. 3 Grujicic Klensi Fantastic Of Miki. Not quite the proportions of first and second in previous class but still a lot to like him. Excellent coat and handsome head with strong neck. Good tight feet. Moved ok.
- VB (1) 1 Harries Myrna Loy. 8 year old who was enjoying her day out, lovely head with kind expression, well laid shoulders and with good proportions. Moved well for her age. Have judged this bitch in her younger days but has now got middle age spread. Well handled.
- PB (2) 1 Turnbull's Kimmax Two Kan Play At Elagram (AI). 9 month bitch who is typical from this kennel. Good facial furnishings and strong neck. With good forechest and length of rib. Moderate hind angulation, moved well for a youngster, Best Puppy. 2 Jarman's Shortridge Broadway Belle. Just under 12 months old with moderate angulation and not as good a topline as first with a tail set that was a little low. Good tight feet, moved soundly.
- PGB (6) Biggest class of the day and some lovely bitches were in it.
- 1 Johnston's Glenquinn Enyo. This bitch is maturing nicely and is another lovely bitch sired by a lovely dog who has passed a lot of his attributes onto his progeny. Sufficient furnishings and equal length skull and muzzle, strong neck and slightly sloping top line with correct tail set. straight forelegs with slightly sloping pasterns, moved with drive to take the Res CC. 2 Sharkey's Kimmax Baby Come Black. 2 yr old black and white bitch with good head furnishings and eyebrows. Not quite the lay of shoulder as first, but a lot to like about her. She needs to mature as the best is yet to come. Well handled to take second place in this strong class. 3 Jenkins & Warner's Glenquin Artemis For Gerstenfield.
- LB (4) 1 McCullough's Kimmax Kindly Stand Black. Litter sister to second in previous class. Moved better than her sister. Head with good furnishings Moderate neck and good lay of shoulder with good fore chest. Well balanced and tail set continues off the topline, with moderate angulaton. Expertly handled by her owner/handler. 2 Kavanagh & Caffel's Hushwing Louboutin To Doberway. 5 year old bitch. Seems like yesterday that she was a puppy, but is now fully mature. She has a lovely outline and is moderate throughout with nice tight well padded feet. Moved out with confidence. 3 Johnston's Glenquin Athena.
- OB (4) 1 Herczeg's Hu Ch Fantasic Of Miki Ww21 Ew 21. I was speechless when this bitch came into the ring. She is one of the highest quality bitches that have judged in this breed and is a deserving International Champion. Sufficient furnishings and strong neck going onto well laid shoulders. Good length of back and of perfect proportions Excellent jacket and put down to perfection. Drove round the ring with well muscled hind quarters on a free stride. BCC and BOB. She looked fabulous in the main ring. 2 Johnston's Sh Ch /Bel Ch Canis Fortuna Harda. Mother of Bitch RCC winner and a deserves being a Show Champion. Sufficient furnishings and well laid

shoulders, good length of back. Beat another quality bitch on her correct tailset and movement. 3 Jenkins & Warner's Glequinn Artemis For Gerstenfield.

Field Trial B (1) Third in Post Grad and litter sister to my RCC winner but not quite as mature as her. Tail appears to be a little long but she used it well on the move. Well muscled as a working dog should be.

GCB (3) 1 Jones' Dregheda Desert Song. 2 Harries' Myrna Loy. 3 Harries' Dregheda If Were Single. A nice trio of well proportioned bitches all being a little portly but were enjoying their day out.
