Special Beginners Dog (1) 1 Geary, Rudishaw Good on Ya. 22 months and is fair all through. Good proportions in head, clear in eye with good dentition. Plenty in neck. Overall body proportions display good balance. Bone is ok with correct feet. He is sound going away but a bit loose on the return, but was presented in fit hard muscle tone.

PD (1) 1 Geary, Geary, Wesley Vom Alte at Germanus (RAF, NAF, IMP). Only six months old but displays such promise with an eye-catching appearance. Head has correct proportions, a large open nose with a clear eye. Excellent in dentition and all topped off with neat well placed ears. His overall balance on the stack displays correct balance. He stands on correct bone with neat feet. For one so young he displayed a free flowing action on the out and back whilst holding a pleasing profile on the go around. Should go on to bigger and better things. BP.

JD (1) 1 Jones, Germanus Makin a Point (AI) 13 months. Very honest individual of good breed type. Head is masculine which has correct balance. Eye is clear with strength in foreface. Neck flows into a clean front assembly with enough in forechest. Ribbing is ok with correct topline. He stands on good bone with well knuckled neat feet. Put his best foot forward on the out and back displaying ok reach and drive. However, was rather proud of his tail!

YD (1) 1 Brown, Matravers Cherokee. Correct in head which has good balance. Kind in eye with good dentition all finished off with good furnishings. Neck has strength with plenty in rib. Topline is solid which leads to a firm loin. He stands on good bone with neat feet. On the stack he projects a balanced outline. On the move going away he displayed parallel rear drive but was somewhat restricted in forward reach, but was well presented.

OD (2) 1 Pinkerton, Pinkerton, Alimov, Sh Ch Ch Matze Vom Alte Wald (Imp). A privilege to be given the opportunity to go over this high class exhibit. Masculine in head which displays equal balance. Kind in eye with excellent dentition. Neat well placed ears all finished off with neat furnishings. His neck flows into a clean front assembly with a well filled forechest. Ribbing is carried well back to a firm loin Topline is solid with correct underline. He stands on correct bone with excellent feet. It's on the move that the issue is put to bed. He displays such power with reach and drive on the out and back whilst holding his outline at all times he simply asked for it and I was pleased to award him BD and BoB and later on he was still on form in the Group, and I was delighted to witness him claim Group 3. Congratulations! 2 Jones, Jones, Sh Ch, Ch Mustwork Uland. Judged this chap in the past and admired him then before he gained his crown, He has so much to admire all through. Typical in head, eye and expression. Powerful in neck. Clean in front assembly. Excellent in rib, solid in topline. Bone and feet all good. He moved out with correct footfalls and projected a pleasing profile on the go around. No disgrace here. RBD.

Special Beginners Bitch (1) 1 Jones, Jones, Germanus Dutch Delight. 4 year old mature individual of some merit. Feminine in head which has correct proportions. Kind in eye, plenty in neck. Bone is ok with good feet. On the stack she displays good overall balance. Today, however, I felt she was carrying a little too much weight whilst carrying her tail a touch too high, but warranted Best SB.

JB (2) 1 Newton, Germanus Making a Ripple with Layasway, 14 months old. Feminine in head which has equal proportions. Clear in eye with correct dentition neck flows into a clean front assembly. Plenty in ribbing with a firm topline. Her general body outline on the stack gives off a pleasing outline; she stands on good bone with neat feet. She was positive on the out and back but tended to carry her tail rather high but was presented in excellent jacket. 2 Harries, Gleomac Daffodils in Bloom (AI) 16 months. Enough to admire all through feminine in head with correct eye and expression. General body outline displays good balance. Topline is level with plenty in rib bone and feet ok. Just needs to settle on the out and back but was presented in good order.

YB 1st Stamp, Tynsil Just One Smile. Judged this exhibit last year as a puppy. Liked her then and still do. Feminine in head which has correct proportions. Kind in eye with excellent definition. Plenty in neck with good front assembly general outline displays good balance. Topline is level which leads to a well set tail. She has quality in her bone with neat compact feet. She moved out with purpose on the out and back. Now at the juvenile stage she still needs time to develop in body, this will happen in time. RBB today. 2 Kearns, Rudishaw Waltzing Matilda, 22 months. Enough about this one to admire. Scores in head, eye and expression. Neck is sufficient. Ribbing is carried well back with a firm topline. Bone and feet are good. Another that is still developing in

body. Moved away ok but was rather loose on the return. In time this should correct itself, but was presented in good order.

OB (2) 1 Morris, Evans, Bareve by Kind Permission. Quality exhibit to go over of overall correct size. Her head is feminine which displays correct proportions. Kind in eye which gives off a gentle expression with good eyebrows and beard. Plenty in neck which flows into a clean front assembly. She is well filled in her forechest. Ribbing is carried well back to a firm loin Topline is solid and leads to a well set tail all finished off with a well muscled rear. She stands on quality bone with neat feet On the out and back she displays accurate footfalls whilst holding her profile on the go around. Coat was presented in good order. VB (1) 1 Harries, Myran Loy. 10 year old of vintage status enjoying her day out. Head, eye and expression all ok Still retains body condition.
