PD (1) 1 Jones's Germanus Makin A Point, GWP. Well made puppy with good bone and substance throughout. Pleasing head, but still needs to darken in eye. Best of legs and feet, firm back and well developed hindquarters for his age. Moved well on a good stride but is just a tad proud of his tail which detracted from his overall appearance on the move, BPD. OD (4,1) 1 Graham & Yarrow's Sh.Ch. Bonapartist Pickpocket, Brittany. Quality throughout, good size and presents a very typical outlook, square and cobby as the standard asks for. Best of heads, good eye and kind expression. Deep chest, well ribbed, short backed and good strength of quarters. Presented in excellent coat and condition. Moved positively on a brisk stride, BD & BOB. 2 Anderson's Rochus Noble, Brittany. Very well balanced and presented a very typical outlook. Another of good size, pleasing substance but is not overdone in anyway. Head of correct proportions, well set ears and correct eye shape. Firm body, big ribs, strong hindquarters along with a moderate bend of stifle. Sound on the move, RBD. 3 Pont's Oakmarsh Haunting Howl, Chesapeake Bay Ret.

VB (2) 1 Watts Oakmarsh Acorn VW SGWC, Chesapeake Bay Ret. Very much belies her age of 13. Keeps her shape stood and on the move and is in such great condition for her age. Good head and eye. Pleasing reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Well sprung ribs, nicely rounded quarters and a good bend of stifle. Moved well. 2 Axtell's NI.Ch. Patoucha Lyra for Callmillard, Brittany. Another who has kept a good shape and clean outline. Balanced head with a very typical outlook. Good depth of chest, short back and a firm topline that she held on the move.

PB (2) 1 Anderson's Rochus Tina, Brittany. Very promising youngster. Good size and has the required square and cobby appearance. Balanced head of correct proportions, bright expression and well set ears. Excellent depth of chest for her age, short back, well rounded ribs and pleasing hindquarters. Had a very typical action on the move, brisk with the required short stride as the standard asks for. BPB & BP. 2 Speck's Sarscottah Du Specktacular, GLP. Pleasing size and well made throughout. Balanced head, typical appearance but still needs to darken eye but has time on her side. Well developed body for her age, pleasing depth and nicely rounded hindquarters. Once she settled moved well.

PGB (3,1) 1 Slack's Bonapartist Snow Goose, Brittany. Typey bitch who was put down on the day in super coat and condition and was expertly handled by her young owner to get the most out of her at all times. Lovely head, eye and expression. Firm body, good depth of chest and strong muscular quarters. Very positive on the move. 2 Watts Oakmarsh Freedom, Chesapeake Bay Ret. Presents a well balanced appearance. Good bone and substance throughout. Good head piece, pleasing front assembly, strong back and good width of hindquarters and well bent stifles. Moved soundly on a free and easy stride.

OB (7,4) 1 Morris & Evan's Bareve By Kind Permission, GWP. Good size along with the correct height to length ratio as asked for in the standard. Pleasing strength throughout but shows no sign of coarseness. Typical in head with a good eye and expression. Good reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Firm topline, good tailset and strong well muscled quarters. Moved soundly, BB. 2 Watt's Sh Ch Oakmarsh Chestnut, Chesapeake Bay Ret. Well balanced outlook. Best of heads, pleasing expression and well placed ears. Good front assembly standing on the best of legs and feet. Well sprung ribs, powerful hindquarters and a good bend of stifle. Correct double coat of good texture. Moved well both fore and aft, Res BB. 3 Thomas, Taylor & Richards Sophisticated Lady, GLP.
