

PD (2) 1 Xaver Iv V Böckenhagen NAF (Hewins), well up to size, nicely balanced head and expression, ok bone decent rib, good coat. Liked his head and expression. Moved ok, but needs to settle BP. 2 Matrevers Cherokee (Brown), needs to mature, lacked in foreface and eye needs to darken, lacked bone, ok bend of stifle but too much croup. Moved ok. Coat ok.

JD (1) 1 Kimmax They Kall Me Mr Tibbs (Donnelly), very pleasing head and eye, very good bone and fill to body, good rib, has strength of loin. Presented in good coat and condition. Tidy coming and going good stride in profile.

LD (1) 1 Germanus Hit The Jackplot (Geary). I really like this dog, but he was not showing to advantage. Lovely head and expression with the correct furnishings, good bone and fill to chest, strength of loin and nicely muscled and angled rear. Clean in hock. Tidy coming and going, in profile was a bit unbalanced, at two years his time will come. A good jacket, handler needs training.

OD (6,2) 1 Ft Ch Tickencote One Way Ticket (Russell), solid liver, when he walked in I thought that looks good, very typical stamp, super head and expression, well made throughout. Very clean coming and going and in profile presented a smooth action just eating the ring up. Super correct coat with a dense undercoat. A credit to owners/breeders. CC his third I believe well done. A pleasure to judge. 2 Poldi vom Broel (Joseph), another one presents a very typical outline with the best of coats, again another with the correctly balanced head with a clean eye. Good bone and well made with out exaggeration. Tidy clean mover, today could not match the profile of one RCC. 3 Sh Ch Kimmax Knock Yourself Out JW ShCM (Donnelly)

PB (2,1) 1 Tynsil Just One Smile (Stamp), she has moments when you see she has it. Needs to body up and her coat to develop. Another solid liver with a lovely balanced head and good eye. Handler needs longer legs for her, but I am sure she will come and flourish. JB (4) 1 Germanus Stands Out A Mile (Geary), another very pleasing bitch displaying typical breed stance with co-ordinated active movement, holding topline. She has a lovely head with good furnishings strength of neck and decent done and rib. Clean behind with good musculature. Has a decent coat, texture could be a little harsher but overall a very good prospect. 2 Kimmax Two Kan Play at Elagram (ai) (Turnbull) good well balanced head and typical expression, good bone and spring of rib, a shade long in loin, but overall a typical stamp. Nicely muscled. Decent coat. 3 Rudishaw Waltzing Matilda (Kearns)

LB (4,1) 1 Bareve Burra Burra Lake (Pinkerton), presented a typical medium sized bitch with super balance and bone. Good rib and fill and strength of loin, correct backline and nicely muscled with a good bend of stifle and clean hock. Has a lovely balanced head with that typical GWP expression and good furnishings, strength of neck. Coat is correct with a decent undercoat. Tidy coming and going and present good reach and drive in profile, close up RCC. 2 Glenquin Enyo (Johnston) not as clean in outline as one and slightly longer. Moved ok and was decent in profile. Decent coat asnd condition. Nice balanced head decent expression. 3 Bareve by Kind Permission TAF (Morris & Evans)

OB (3) 1 Sh Ch Glenquin Athena (Johnston) – a well balanced bitch with a good typical head and expression. Good bone and feet, decent fill to chest and good spring of rib, strength of loin and nicely angled behind, clean hock. Tidy coming and going and super profile movement holding topline and good head definition. A good jacket of correct texture. CC & BOB. 2 Sh Ch Kimmax Kindly Stand Black (McCullough) very pleasing head and expression , well built throughout and in a super jacket, just could not match the balance and outlook of my winners today but a pleasure to judge. 3 Sh Ch/bel Ch Canis Fortuna Harda (Johnston)
