PD (1) 1 Caldewriver Cold As Ice (O'Brien). What a great start, this stunning young chap. Construction is hard to fault, Balanced and typical throughout, with good angles, strong legs and firm hocks. Very smart head piece, muscled through, topped by thick harsh top coat. Moved covering the ground easily. BP.

JD (3) 1 Germanus Hotwyr Yindi (Quinn & Skeemer). Masculine and of good proportions. Decent head, neck flows through firm back to decent tail. Well boned and stands his ground well. He has decent action and shows a sound temperament. 2 Germanus Black in Bizniz (Geary). Not as forward as the winner and ribs don't lead as well back. He actually displays a better picture on the move, but at that teenage stage, so this can change with maturity. He has muscle and pleasing coat texture. He has breed points and feel another year could show a different picture. 3 Germanus Makin A Point (ai) (Jones).

YD (3,1) 1 Kimmax They Kall Me Mr Tibbs (Donnelly). A quite impressive male. He has proportions and balance to depict breed type and is soundly put together, which is reflected in his good foot placement and easy long stride. He worked with handler well and had maturity to win his place and Res DCC. 2 Rudishaw Good On Ya (Kearns & Thomas)

PGD (2) 1 Kimmax Kallin Danny Boy over (Mrs J A Shepherd) he is masculine and has decent body proportions. Pleasing expression from well fitting eye, Good stop to strength in muzzle. Developed rib, leading well back to short firm loin. Tidy mover. 2 Greendale Ash (Simpson). Pleasing head with balance and masculinity. Stands on well boned legs, would prefer more angulation in shoulders. Strong outline. Tight coat, but texture is good.

LD (1) 1 Bareve Best Done Now (Chrystie). 3 years and is typical in outline, which is retained on the move. He has good bone. Could be shorter in loin and have more muscle. Lovely temperament and went ok.

OD (4) 1 Ukr Ch Matze vom Alte Wald NAF (Pinkerton & Viacheslav). Stood away in this class standing and when he moves he is a force to be reckoned with. He is fit, muscled throughout and has a super body coat. Obviously well constructed or he wouldn't move as he does, which frankly, I could watch all day. DCC & BOB. 2 Sh Ch/Ir Sh Ch Kimmax Knock Yourself Out JW ShCM (Donnelly). Has type and pleased for outline and proportions. Not the body, muscle or power of the winner. Has a decent coat. 3 Kimmax Kort in Action (McCullough).

VD (1) 1 Sh Ch/Deu/vdh Ch Kimmax Kurious George Bs '17 Bs '18 (McCullough). Lot to like in this dog, even as a veteran, can still stand his own against lots. In good body, in fact pleased all through and has quality Felt handler did not do him justice at times or could have been in for higher honours, as I liked him a lot. BV.

PB (2) 2 quality puppies. 1 Caldewriver Storm N' Teacup for Katillien (O'Brien). What a gorgeous bitch. A pleaser to go over as she is so well constructed and well bodied with muscled. Expertly handled and has the character to work with handler to put on a stylist accurate performance. This won't be the last time, either her or the dog puppy will figure and top awards can't be far away for either. 2 Kenzduo Fusilli (Simpson). 9 month and a grand sort, being well made and decent for size and proportions. Not really on it today, but her time will come when she gets a bit of maturity into her head. She has bone and substance.

JB (4) 1 Hushwing's Encanto (Luxmoore & Luxmoore-Ball). This one has to go over to be appreciated. Doesn't always make the best of herself standing, but it all comes together on the move, which is where she scored today. Her coat is close, but of good texture.. Think as she grows on and relaxes into her job, she will present a better picture standing. BJ. 2 Germanus Hotwyr Minjarra (Geary) Standing thought she would be my winner, lovely type and handled well. She has pleasing head, length to leg is typical and she works with handler. Just a bit messy coming to me today. 3 Germanus Makin A Ripple with Layasway (Newton).

YB (4,1) 3 decent bitches. 1 Rudishaw Waltzing Matilda (Miss B Kearns). Smart and stylish. Has a lovely head piece and strength in neckline through decent forehead. Good bone legs and feet Long rib to

short filled loin. Totally at one with handler, to win. 2 Tynsil Just One Smile (Stamp). Feminine with substance. She again, scores in head. Has balance and typical proportions. Developed body and muscular quarters. Goes with good foot fall, but not just as fluid, maybe because of change of handler. 3 Kimmax Thats Klassified (Flowers).

PGB (1) 1 Kimmax Who Kares Wins JW (Donnelly). Honest and soundly made with lovely head, correct skull clean cheeks, has stop to strength in muzzle. Muscular neck, through decent forehand. Good bone. Harsh well fitting coat. Worked with purpose, reach and drive. Res CC.

LB (6,1) 1 Luchanalilly Cute Coral of Caldewriver (O'brien). Well this is a grand sort. She has it all going on and was so well turned out and handled, that it just all came together on the move to produce a really quality picture of foot fall, smooth, long, with scope of stride and retained shape, therefore could not be got past in the challenge and pushed the male to the wire. BCC. 2 Bareve by Kind Permission (Morris & Evans). Has quality and skeletally well made. Produced in good body and coat. Sound standing and moving. I did prefer head of the winner, but a decent bitch. 3 Kimmax Two Kan Play at Elagram (ai) (Turnbull).

OB (5) 1 Sh Ch Kimmax Kindly Stand Black (Mccullough) Honest bitch who has decent head proportions, lovely expression and muzzle. She has a decent forehand, good length of frib, firm back and well set tail. Did enough on the move. 2 Sh Ch/ir Sh Ch Beechillawn Oooh Betty (Donnelly). Not quite the total balance of the winner and not as strong in hoch, but has type in outline and blots of breed essentials. Handled well. 3 Kimmax Klean Sweep (Shepherd)

VB (1) 1 Bareve Bela Bela (Chrystie). Has shape and good temperament. A touch steep in shoulders. Lacks a little bone and substance. Has harsh coat.
