Good boned legs and correct feet. He has a very typical outline when settled with strong slightly sloping topline and correct underline. Keeps his shape on the move, he is sound and free moving with good drive, moves straight down and back. Should do well if he continues his early promise, RCC and BP. 2 Jones & Jones' Germanus Makin A Point, different in type to one and not as together at this stage. Typical head and alert expression. Good straight boned legs and good depth chest for age. Compact feet. Moderately angulated, moved freely. Excellent coat texture.

RCC 2 Jones & Jones' Germanus Dutch Delight, different type to 1, preferred 1 in outline and rear quarters. Feminine head and kind eyes, compact feet, good depth of chest and spring of rib. Correct coat texture. Sound moving. 3 Turnbull & Turnbull & Turnbull, Kimmax Two Kan Play At Elagram (AI) OB (5) 1 Johnston & Johnston & Johnston Sh Ch Glenquin Athena. Exceptional quality bitch who was a pleasure to judge. I found her so typical of our breed, correctly balanced outline with slightly sloping topline, correct body proportions being slightly longer than tall. Her underline is correct, ribs reaching well back to tucked up loins. Her coat is correct with depth and texture. She moves with power, smooth and ground covering and so sound. A pleasure to judge and one I would be happy to own. BCC and BOB. 2 Mccullough & Mccullough's Sh Ch Kimmax Kindly Stand Black. Quality young bitch, balanced head, dark eyes and alert expression. Good neck, clean shoulders, balanced bone, straight legs and compact feet. Strong slightly sloping topline. Correct tailset and carriage, short hocks to ground. Free moving. 3 Donnelly's Beechillawn OOh Betty.
