

JD (3,0) 1. Turnbull & Turnbull & Turnbull & Keene's Glenquin The Colonel at Elagram - young dog with lots to like, head balanced with broad skull, forelegs straight with strong pasterns, deep chest with well sprung ribs, hindquarters broad and well muscled. Coat of the correct texture and length with sufficient head furnishings. On the move he gave his handler a hard time with his eagerness to please but when he settled, he demonstrated a ground covering driving action. Pushed hard in the challenge for BD.

RBD 2. Robson's Glenquin Major at Yohenoak -another young dog who was unfortunate to meet the first today. Masculine head with moderate stop, correct furnishings and length of beard, neck muscular leading to well laid back shoulders, deep chest, ribs reaching well back, muscular hindquarters with well bent stifles. Moved true with a driving action, but not the tail carriage of the first. 3. Lovatt & Lovatt & Gettings

Beechillawn Break The Mould (IKC) PGD (1,0) 1. Jones Germanus Makin A Point (ai) – masculine headed who would benefit from more furnishings, coat of the correct length and texture, straight forelegs with strong pasterns, deep chest, would prefer more turn of stifle, correct length of tail. On the move he was over reaching today. OD (5,0) 1.

Donnelly's Ir Sh Ch Kimmax They Kall Me Mr Tibbs – liked the overall balance of this dog both stacked and on the move. He moved true front and rear, using his hindquarters to cover plenty of ground. Masculine head with the required furnishings, straight forelegs with well laid back shoulders and enough length to his upper arm. Hips broad and well muscled thighs, with enough turn to his stifle. His coat was harsh in texture with the required dense undercoat. BD 2. McCullough's Sh Ch/deu/vdh Ch Kimmax Kurious George Bs17/18 – slightly smaller frame than the first and not as pleasing on the eye on the move as the first. Shown in a muscular hard condition, his outer coat was thick with a dense undercoat. Angulation correct front and rear and hocks well let down. 3.

Donnelly's Ir Sh Ch/int Sh Ch Beechillawn Raspberry Sorbet Cjw22 Cw22/23 Cen Ch Cen JW Cenw Jch PGB (2,0) 1. Shepherd's Kimmax Klean Sweep – very feminine headed bitch, with correct amount of furnishings, ears set high, strong neck leading to well laid back shoulders. Straight forelegs with closing fitting elbows, enough depth to her chest and ribs carried well back. Coat thick and harsh in texture, Covered the ground well on the move. RBB 2. Jones's Germanus Dutch Delight – built on a slightly bigger frame than the first but still in proportion. Head balanced with broad skull, enough whiskers and eyebrows to give the typical expression. Well laid back shoulders with good spring of rib, muscular hindquarters. Moved true away and back. OB (4,0) 1. McCullough's Sh Ch Kimmax Koz I Kan – so much to like about this bitch, full of breed type, correct body proportions, outer coat thick and harsh with a dense undercoat with bushy eyebrows and beard. She held her outline on the move where she covered plenty of ground with a smooth driving action. Feminine head, sloping shoulders with good length of upper arm, depth to her chest, straight forelegs, muscular hindquarters and good turn of stifle. BB & BOB 2. Donnelly's Ir Sh Ch Kimmax Who Kares Wins JW – slightly shorter coupled than the first, head balanced throughout with correct amount of furnishings, straight forelegs and strong pasterns, shoulders well laid back. Her coat was the correct texture and she

moved true coming and going. 3. Lovatt & Lovatt & Gettings Ir Sh Ch Beechillawn Mint
