

PD (1,0) 1 Gloudemans Reajeager Stieg. Well balanced dog who has good bone and slight slope to pastern. Nice feet. Pleasing head with well set ears and his proportions on the head are good. Good width to skull. Enough beard and cheek. His topline is super and he has good hindquarters. Moved really well. A very smart puppy. BPIB. JD (1,0) 1 Morris & Evans Beanalrem Gwyndu. He has good leg length to body depth. Good enough ribbing. He is moderate on hindquarters. Just a tad long in rear pastern. Very nice shoulder and good head planes. Good coat texture just would like a more level topline on the move. PGD (3,1) 1 Johnstons Glenquin The General. Really nice mover on the around. Good tail set and moderate in his angulation front and rear. Good bone and feet, straight and true in front. Dark eye and with nice expression when not overshadowed by too much beard. Topline is good. Coat texture is correct. Bone and feet are good. Moved soundly. 2 Robsons Glenquin Major at Yohenoak. Very nice in type. Moderate through his angulations just a little high on the tail set. Lovely bone and feet. He has a good foreface and expression although just a shade strong through the zygomatic arch. His quarters are good just needs a tad more length to croup but he sits into himself very well. Free and easy mover on the around just loses his topline slightly. LD (2,0) 1 O'Briens Caldewriver Cold As Ice. Smaller sized dog but well balanced and constructed. Head is balanced but just a little plain. He has good fill in front. Very nice over his shoulder, well ribbed back. Good bone. Croup and tail set are best in this class. Moves very well and has good coat texture. 2 Turnbulls Glenquin The Colonel at Elagram JW. This dog is quite commanding in many ways but he does have a bit of a slope to his topline. Good bone and feet. Lovely shoulders just a little wide in front. Ribbing is okay. Super on the quarters and wide first and second thigh. Good rear pasterns. Good head and expression. On the around he unfortunately didn't hold the topline I wanted to see. OD (3,1) Two very nice, typey dogs here. Both in good coat. 1 Donnellys Ir Sh Ch/int Sh Ch Beechillawn Raspberry Sorbet Cjw22 Cw22/23 Cen Ch Cen JW Cenw Jch. Won this class on his reachy, driving movement. Good topline and tail set. Lovely shoulders. Straight, quality bone and good feet. His back skull is good and okay ears. I like the finish on his nose. He's got really nice quarters and very nice over the croup with good ribbing. He moved very well. RCC. 2 McCulloughs Kimmax Kiss Ma Blackside at Beechillawn. Straight in front with very nice feet. Good in shoulder. Lovely, moderate quarters with wide first and second thigh and moderate bend of stifle. Just slightly high on tail set. Well ribbed up. Good topline and coat texture and moved well. Another quality dog. VD (1,0) 1 McCulloughs Sh Ch/deu/vdh Ch Kimmax Kurious George Bs17/18 . 9 year old imposing dog. This dog has quality bone and super feet. Correct height to length body proportions. Completely correct tail set. Quarters are fabulous, moderate not overdone good width through first and second thigh with enough bend of stifle. His elbows sit tight under himself. He has a good forehand, lovely shoulders, long ribs. Great coat texture. His head proportions are good and not overdone in beard. Super topline and such ease of carriage on the around - he just glides. Beautiful dog. DCC. JB (1,0) 1 Vine & Hassells Beanalren Grapevine. Very nice front assembly. Her head

proportions are good. Super foreface with big nose and good underjaw. Really nice ear placement and good on the skull. She has a very nice shoulder and upper arm and sits into her front very well. Her bone and feet are very good. She has quite good ribbing with enough spring, still only 13 months. Coat texture is good, just a little untidy going away on the move. BJIB. PGB (1,0) 1 Ijildez vom Holstef at Ovetil (Imp Svk). Very balanced bitch who moved very well on the around. She is nicely moderate. Her proportions are good. She stands on good bone and feet. Her head proportions are balanced. Lovely big nose and well placed ears. Nicely shaped skull. Would just like a slightly darker eye. Well laid shoulders. Good ribbing and moderate hindquarters. She moves really well on the around maintaining her topline and carries herself very well. LB (4,1) 1 Kimmax Two Kan Play at Elagram (ai). Great moving bitch. Would just like a wee bit more depth on her. Straight in bone. Pleasing enough in head. Very nice shoulder. Ribs of good length. Moderate in hindquarters would like a bit more development in second thigh. Croup of good length. Coat texture is good. 2 Pinkerton Bareve Beyoncé. More my style of bitch but she just loses out through her croup. She came together very well on the move, although her poor handler couldn't maintain it - the new one did ok though! She has the best of heads. Straight in bone and good in front. Much to like in many departments. 3 Tickencote Teach Me Tonight for Gerstenfeld JW (Jenkins). OB (6,0) What a lovely class. The first four girls are of the highest quality and I could give a CC to any of them, however, decisions have to be made on the day and on performance. Litter sisters headed this class with very little to separate them. 3rd placed girl is just a little younger and just needs to fill out a wee bit more. 1 Johnstons Sh Ch Glenquin Athena. Beautiful bitch who has the most delicious, breed typical, head piece. Oozes type and quality. Excellent topline, moderate quarters. Not overdone. Super upper arm angulation and good through shoulder line. Stands on good bone and feet. On the move she was glorious to watch. Loved almost everything about her - thanks for the pleasure! BCC & BOB. 2 Johnstons Glenquin Enyo. Many of the same remarks apply to this litter sister. She has a top class topline, tail set and hindquarters. Well-developed correctly angulated front assembly and decent head piece. For me the final decision lay on the winner having the slightly better head but really it was nip and tuck. This girl also moved beautifully. I would be a very proud breeder if I was Glenquin! RCC. 3 O'Briens Sh Ch Caldewriver Storm N' Teacup for Katillien JW. VB (1,0) 1 Johnstons Sh Ch/bel Ch Canis Fortuna Harda. A quality bitch with everything in the right place. Just a little soft on her topline today. Her length to height proportions are fabulous. Love her head, well-proportioned foreface and back skull. Super on the quarters. Excellent bone.
