Excellent head and eye, well constructed throughout, strong top-line and good tail set giving a very good outline, very sound mover in good coat, RDCC. 2. Joseph's Pablo vom Broel. Strong upstanding with a good head and eye, excellent body properties, would like more layback of shoulder, strong well muscled hindquarters, not collected on the move as he needed to relieve himself.
- OD (1) 1. Russell's Ch. Tickencote One Way Ticket. Typical head and eye, well constructed throughout, upstanding with a very good outline, excellent depth of chest, strong top-line and good tail set, strong well muscled hindquarters, moved well.

Jenkins/Warner's Tickencote Teach Me Tonight. 7 months, lovely head and eye, very good breed type, well constructed with a very good outline, excellent front, bone and feet, good body properties and well angulated hindquarters, moved very soundly when she settled, BP. 2. Upstanding black/white, very close up, just preferred the head and eye of winner, well developed body, strong hindquarters, good harsh coat, moved well. 3. Stamp's Tynsil Just One Smile.

Lovely head and eye, good body properties well constructed throughout, very good depth of chest, strong loin, would prefer a lower tail carriage when moving, sound mover but rather erratic today.

Lovely head and eye, very well constructed with a lovely outline, strong top-line and good tail set, excellent body properties, good depth of chest and strong loin, in good harsh coat, very sound mover with good reach and drive holding her top-line at all times, BCC. 2. Johnston's Bel Sh Ch. Canis Fortuna Harda (imp POL). Another very well balanced bitch with a pleasing head and eye, well constructed throughout, good body and bone, strong well angulated hindquarters and a good outline, moved soundly. 3. Pinkerton's Bareve Burra Burra Lake.
